A new Diabetes Specialist Nurse led service providing support for patients who have suffered severe hypoglycaemia that required third party assistance in the community.

Our service is available 7 days per week. Patients can expect an initial review within **24hrs** of a referral and a **proactive management plan** will be developed **to prevent recurrence.**
